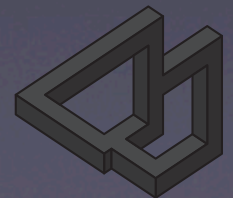

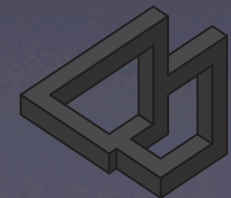
What was “ICT” 1990?

- 📌 We had an incumbent (Televerket)
- 📌 We had one challenger (Comvik)
- 📌 Governments trusted OSI and X.400
- 📌 Televerket refused to look at packet based networks, even though we had customers for the first ISP (that ended up being Swipnet)

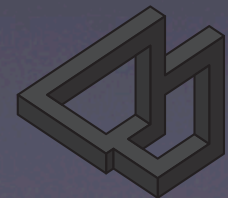
Pragmatist

I really like the consolidated network, but all my PBX features have to work. The phones have to work. Everything else is secondary.



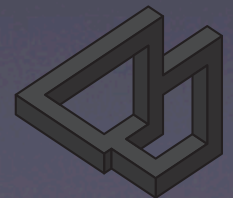
Wild-eyed Radical

Uh, what's a phone?



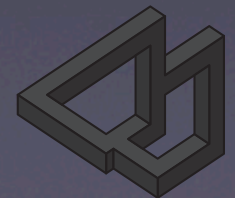
Consumer perspective

- 📌 Lift the receiver of what looks like a phone, and dial 112
- 📌 Nowadays people know they should first dial, and then press “*a green button*”
- 📌 Does it matter if the “call” is over IP, or is a cellphone call or...?



112 as one example

- How to know what number to dial?
- Where to route a call?
- How do the PSAP know where the call is from?
 - Dial back, block number, geographical location
- Across boundaries
 - Including country boundaries

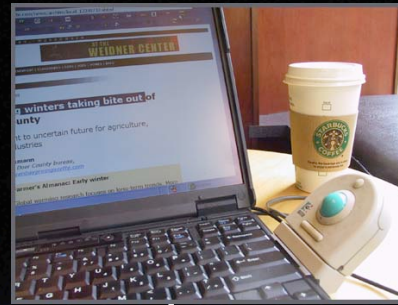
- Investigation about I I 2 to be initiated

- What is I I 2 in the future?



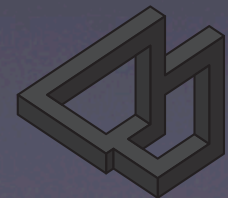
Roaming / mobility

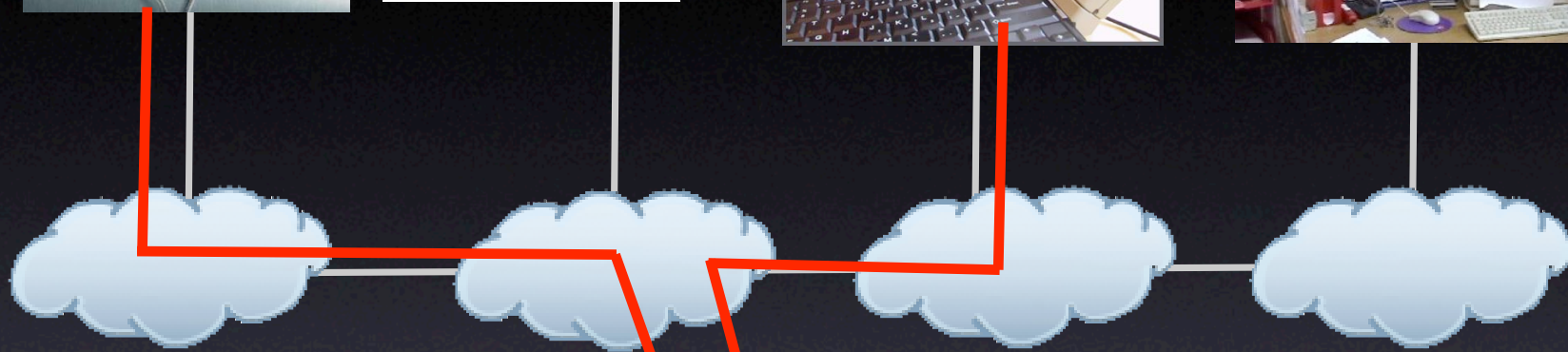
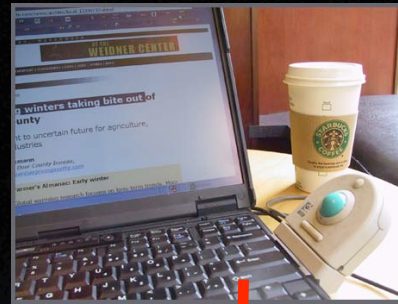
- In many cases a mobile service is something one can access from a cellphone
- In the eyes of the Swedish government IT-bill, mobile service is something one can access from whatever device one want
- This implies the user of the service choose how the user is accessed
- Cellphone is one possible access mechanism among several complementary ones



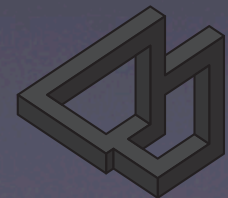

locations

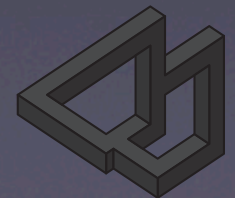




This implies

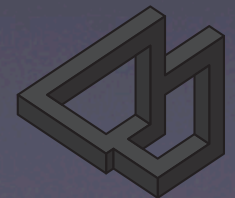

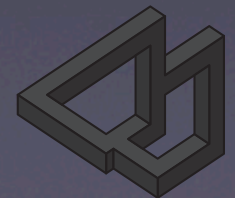

- 📌 What is difference between bundling and lock-in/out?



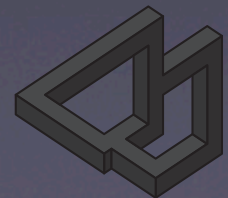
We need a vision!
