New gTLD Program

- Policy developed 2005 2007, adopted in June 2008
- Open approach; no pre-defined number limit, applicants to propose strings
- Clearly defined grounds for objections
- Fees to recover costs
- Rounds initially, aiming at ongoing process later
- Implementation of the policy proposed "Applicant Guidebook", Oct 2008, version 2, Feb 2009
- Version 3, Oct 2009, open for comments until 22 Nov!
- STILL A DRAFT additional iteration before adoption by the ICANN Board

Public comments highlighted:

- Multiple detailed issues...
 - addressed in version 2 and 3

 - Root zone scaling
 - Economic aspects
- Studies and plans published together with version 3



IDNs - Internationalized Domain Names^{TC}

- IDNs currently only on the second level
- IDN TLDs needed for a more globally and culturally inclusive Internet
- IDN gTLDs included in the New gTLD round
- IDN ccTLDs foreseen, policy development ongoing
- "Fast Track" process to satisfy urgent needs for IDN ccTLDs for non-Latin scripts, final implementation plan published 30 September
- "Fast track" approved by the ICANN Board in Seoul. Launch 16 November 2009!
